



Academic Honor Scholarship

The Honor Scholarship is to support the academic pursuits of Current and New Transfer students who demonstrate exceptional academic achievement. The scholarship will cover up to 12 credit hours of tuition and fees. The scholarship does not cover courses outside of the student's degree program, books or development courses. Students who receive an Honor Scholarship are not eligible for any other CBS scholarship.

Award Criteria:

1. Student must complete College of Biblical Studies' Scholarship Application by the deadline.
2. Attend either Fall or Spring term
3. Must be currently in a degree program and enrolled in at least 9 credit hours
4. Current students must have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher.
5. Transfer students must transfer a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher from the most recently attended college or university.

Application Requirements:

1. All High School or GED transcripts and transcripts from previous colleges and universities attended must be on file at CBS.
2. A completed FAFSA, MyFA application, and Scholarship Application
3. Essay – in 400 words or less describe why you are deserving of the scholarship and how the scholarship will enhance your education and ministry.
4. Recommendation Letter – Recommendation letter from a leader in the student's church or a professor or teacher who has knowledge of the student's academic ability.

Students must maintain:

1. Cumulative GPA of at least 3.5 at the end of each term.
2. $\frac{3}{4}$ -time enrollment.
3. Meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) requirements.
4. No outstanding financial obligations, disciplinary actions, or violations of the student code of conduct.
5. Students must notify Enrollment Services if enrollment should change.
Students must reapply at the end of each academic year.
