# CBS Watchman Emergency Notification System Election not to Participate Form

The CBS Watchman Emergency Notification System uses text, e-mail, and voice messages to alert CBS students, employees and faculty in the event of an emergency or urgent situation. Alert messages are sent to registered mobile phones, home phones and e-mail addresses.

Effective Spring 2012, and in accordance with House Bill 2758 that amended the Education Code, CBS is required to automatically include students, faculty and staff in an emergency alert system. The bill further authorizes a student or staff member to elect not to participate in the emergency alert system, which election must be renewed at the start of each academic year.
